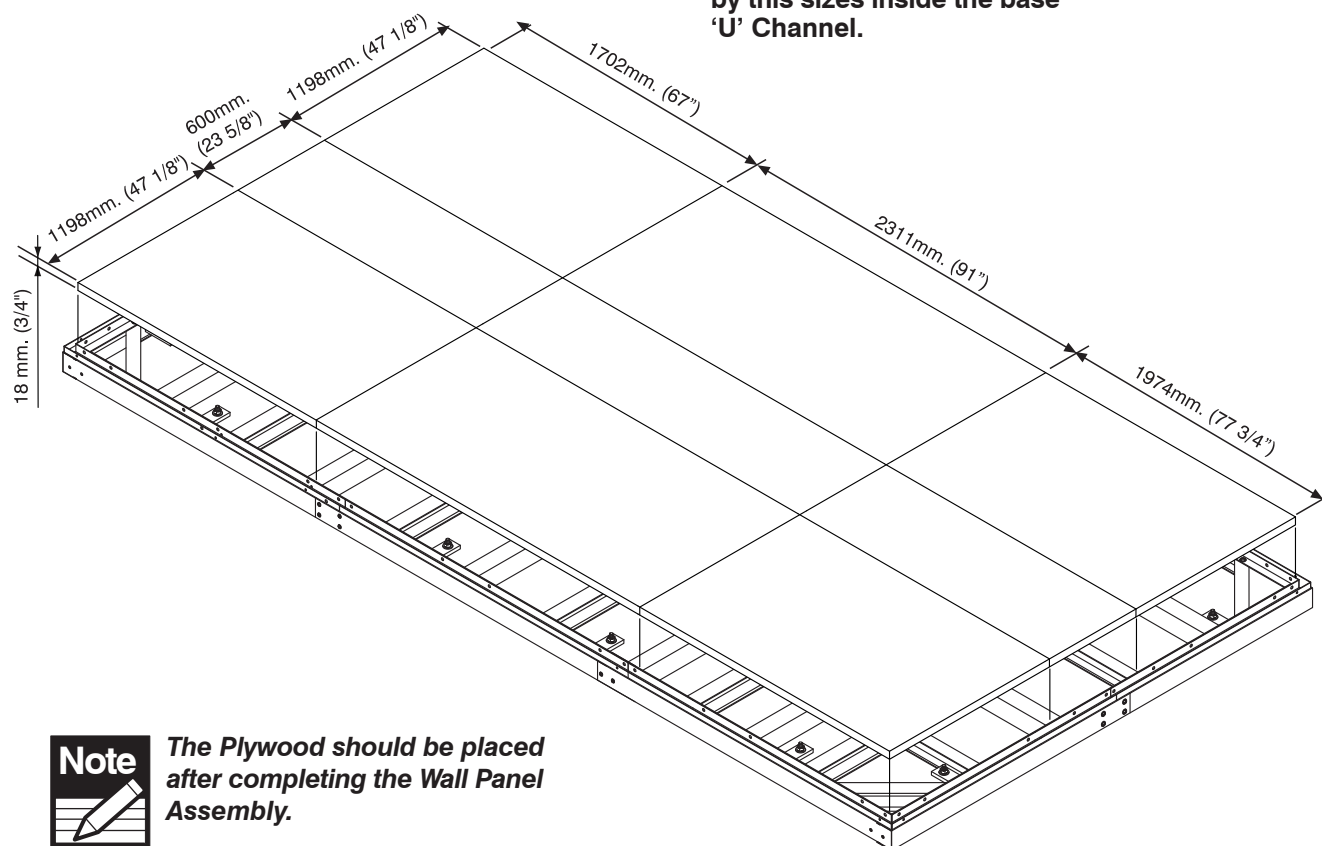
After assemble the Base 'U' Channel it can be filled with concrete up to the Foundation level.

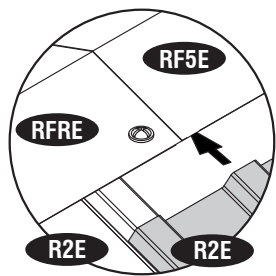


Fig. 1 S10 S16

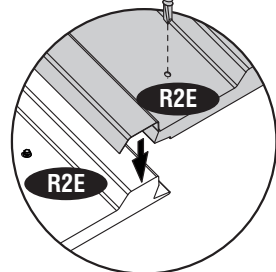
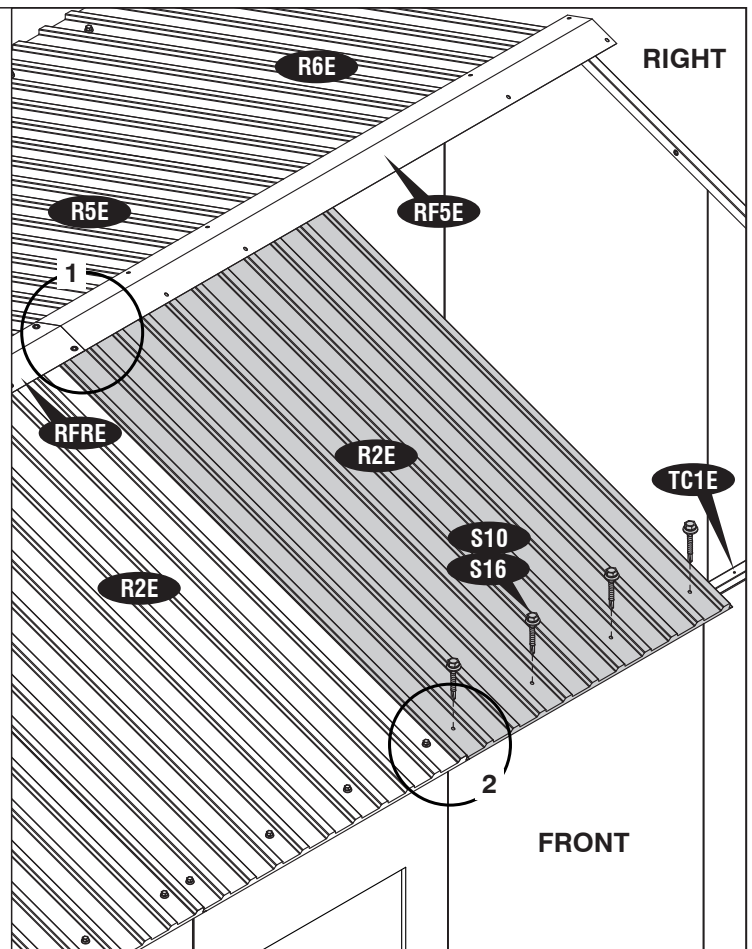
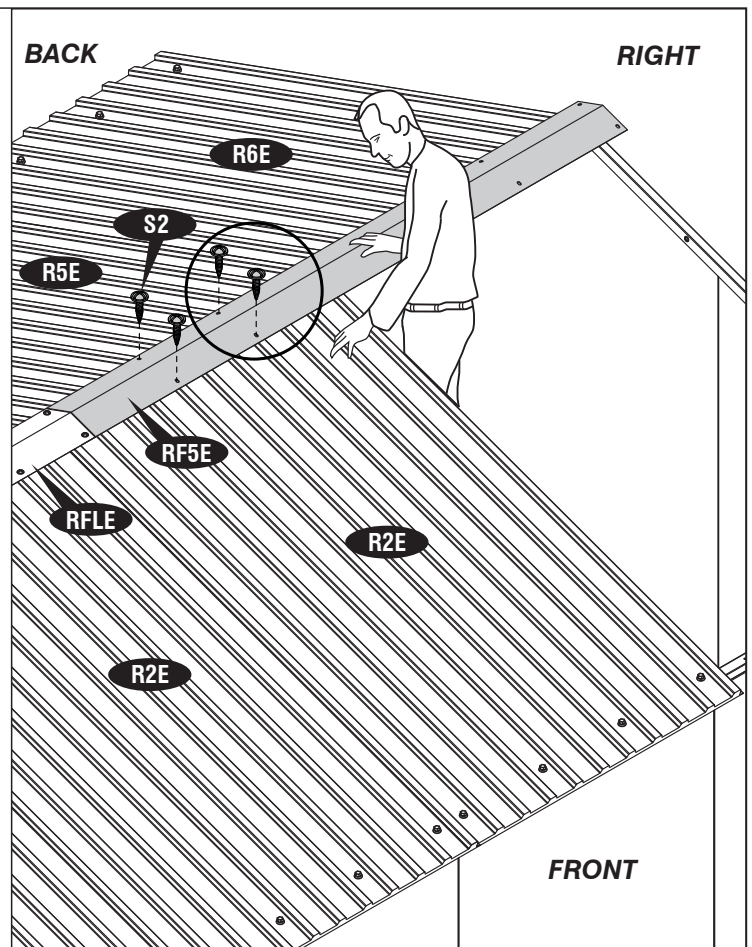
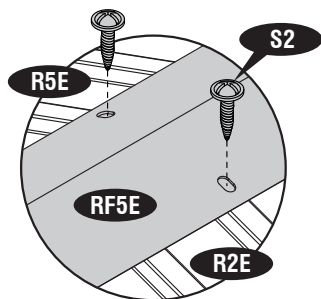
